## Center for Continuing Education

Antioch's Center for Continuing Education (CE) offers professional development opportunities to meet the changing continuing education needs of teachers, leaders and professionals. Through certificate programs, courses, workshops and special events, CE promotes learning as a way of life and Antioch as a center for professional growth. CE participants learn from active professionals in relevant fields who know what's happening now – and what's on the horizon. CE courses and programs offer opportunities to work on projects that draw on real-life situations. Students develop a network of instructors and colleagues and leave classes and programs ready to put into action what they've learned.

CE collaborates with a variety of educational partners who bring additional resources to the community: Heritage Institute, Staff Development for Educators, Education Development Center, Heinemann Publishing, Academy for Coach Training and the Dispute Resolution Center of Snohomish and Island Counties. These partnerships, along with other Antioch CE courses and certificate programs extend Antioch's strengths into the community and further serve the needs of alumni. Courses and programs typically offer continuing education units; select courses and programs for teachers offered through the Center for Programs in Education offer credits and, through the Center for Continuing Education, clock hour options.
